SAMPLE PROGRAM ITINERARY

DAY 1: PANAMA CITY ARRIVAL, ORIENTATION & EXPLORATION

- Faculty travel to Panama City where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported to nearby hotel
- Welcome ‘Panamanian’ dinner and orientation with Country Director and In-Country Team
- With any available time, faculty are welcome to explore Panama City tourist sites

DAY 2: VISIT PARTNER COMMUNITIES, MEET LOCAL MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS + EXPERIENCE PANAMA

- Breakfast & Professional Development Workshops at the hotel. Meet our local medical professionals to learn about our work and how you can get involved.
- Enjoy a delicious lunch!
- Visit partner communities in rural districts of Panama. Get introduced to local culture and understand the economic and social environment of the country.
- Dinner and Evening Presentations and Reflections



DAY 3: COMMUNITY CLINICS, HOLISTIC EXPERIENCE, VISIT TO LOCAL SITES

- Visit another local community to see our programs in person and meet local community health leaders
- Get a sense of our “holistic” development model with an introduction to our business programming
- Afternoon lunch & accommodations visit/tour
- Visit UNESCO Heritage site “Casco Viejo” for Final Celebration Dinner

DAY 4: PROGRAM CLOSURE AND PANAMA DEPARTURE

- Final closing meeting and reflection
- Optional visit to the Panama Canal
- Transport provided from city hotel to the airport
- Faculty are welcome to stay in Panama and travel at
- their own expense if they choose

Who is invited on a Nursing Site Visit?

Any university faculty or administrator from across the country who is interested in and serious about offering a KAMBIA Nursing Program at their university in the future!

Where do we stay during our program?

Faculty stay at a simple and comfortable hotel in Panama City throughout the program. Double rooms with private bath are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon request.

Is there a cost to participate in a Nursing Site Visit?

The Professional Development Fee of \$1550 includes airfare (up to \$1000) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transportation, and cultural activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit on behalf of the registered participant.
