Join university nursing faculty and administrators from across the country as our International Nursing Team guides you through Belize to experience how Kambia provides essential medical services to low-income families across the country. The program includes all airfare, food, lodging,

transport and cultural activities. Take advantage of the opportunity for professional development while experiencing the culture and beauty of Belize, and return home with a deeper sense of confidence and purpose to promote a future Kambia Nursing Program!

## SAMPLE PROGRAM ITINERARY

### DAY 1: BELIZE CITY ARRIVAL, ORIENTATION & EXPLORATION

- Faculty travel to Belize where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported 2 hours to a hotel in the Stann Creek or Cayo District.
- Welcome dinner and orientation with Country Director and In-Country Team

### DAY 2: VISIT PARTNER COMMUNITIES, MEET LOCAL BUSINESS PROFESSIONALS + EXPERIENCE BELIZE

- Breakfast & Professional Development Workshops at the hotel. Meet medical professionals to learn about our work and how you can get involved.
- Enjoy a delicious lunch!
- Visit partner communities in rural districts of Belize where access to healthcare is limited. Get introduced to local entrepreneurs and understand the health and social environment of the country.
- Dinner and Evening Presentations and Reflections





### DAY 3: COMMUNITY HEALTH ASSESSMENT + SCHOOL HEALTH WORKSHOP

- Visit another community to shadow a community health assessment in action. Meet local community health leaders.
- Afternoon lunch & visit to a local school to meet students and present health workshop

### DAY 4: VISIT LOCAL TOURIST SITES INCLUDING MAYAN RUINS AND BEACH TRIP

- Explore local historical sites such as Mayan Ruins as well as nearby tourists sites including a visit to the beach

### DAY 5: PROGRAM CLOSURE AND BELIZE DEPARTURE

- Final closing meeting and reflection
- Transport provided from hotel to the airport
- Faculty are welcome to stay in Belize and travel at their own expense if they choose

#### Who is invited on a Nursing Site Visit?

Any university faculty or administrator from across the country who is interested in and serious about offering a Kambia Nursing Program at their university in the future!

#### Where do we stay during our program?

Faculty stay at a simple and comfortable hotel outside of Belize City throughout the program. Double rooms with private bath are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon request.

#### Is there a cost to participate in a Nursing Site Visit to Belize?

The Professional Development Fee of \$1350 includes airfare (up to \$1000) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transportation, and cultural activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit on behalf of the registered participant.
