SAMPLE PROGRAM ITINERARY

DAY 1: TRAVELING TO ACCRA

• Faculty start their travel to Accra, Ghana.

DAY 2: ORIENTATION & EXPLORATION

- Faculty arrive in Accra where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported to their hotel.
- Welcome dinner and orientation with Country Director and In-Country Team

DAY 3: VISIT PARTNER COMMUNITIES, MEET LOCAL MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS + EXPERIENCE GHANA

- Breakfast & Professional Development Workshops at the hotel. Meet local business professionals to learn about our work and how you can get involved.
- O Enjoy a delicious lunch!
- Visit partner communities in rural Ghana.
 Get introduced to local and understand the health and social environment of the country.
- O Dinner and Evening Presentations and Reflections



DAY 4: COMMUNITY CLINICS, HOLISTIC EXPERIENCE, VISIT TO LOCAL SITES

- Visit another community to see our programs in person and meet local community health leaders.
- Get a sense of our "holistic" development model with an introduction to our business programming
- Afternoon lunch & visit/tour to Cape Coast Castle.

DAY 5: ACCRA TOUR, CULTURAL ACTIVITIES AND CLOSING CELEBRATION

- Closing meeting and reflection.
- Visit to nearby tourist attractions.
- O Final Celebration dinner.

DAY 6: DEPARTURE FROM GHANA

- Transport provided from city hotel to the airport
- Faculty are welcome to stay in Ghana and travel at their own expense if they choose

Who is invited on a Nursing Site Visit?

Where do we stay during our program?

Faculty stay at a simple and comfortable hotel in Accra and nearby towns throughout the program. Double rooms with private bath are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon request.

Is there a cost to participate in a Nursing Site Visit to Ghana?

The Professional Development Fee of \$2200 includes airfare (up to \$1700) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transportation, and cultural activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit on behalf of the registered participant.

STEPS TO PARTICIPATE

- 1. Register: Please fill out the Nursing Site Visit Registration Form to confirm your attendance.
- **2. Submit Professional Development Fee:** Following registration, you will receive an email with a link to submit the <u>\$2200 per faculty member.</u>
- **3. Book Your Flight:** After receiving your Registration & Fee, we connect you with our travel team to book your flight and provide pre-Site Visit materials and pre-program training.
