SAMPLE PROGRAM ITINERARY

DAY 1: TRAVEL TO ATHENS

O Faculty start their travel to Athens

DAY 2: ATHENS ARRIVAL, ORIENTATION & WELCOME ACTIVITIES

- Participants arrive in Athens where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported to a local hotel
- Enjoy a Greek welcome dinner and program orientation with our In-Country Team

DAY 3: INTRODUCTION TO MEDICAL PROGRAM & HOLISTIC EXPERIENCE

- Breakfast and introduction to our Medical Consulting Program
- O Enjoy a delicious lunch at GB's client restaurant
- Get a sense of our "holistic" development model with an introduction to our business program and meet local business owners in Athens
- O Greek language lesson, lunch, and dinner





DAY 4: SHELTER PREPARATION & SHADOW OUR CLINIC

- Shadow Greek doctors as they provide medical services to local refugee and migrant patients
- Prepare for the workshop you will facilitate unaccompanied refugee minors at a shelter for refugee unaccompanied minors
- O Greek cooking lesson, lunch, and dinner

DAY 5: VISIT TO SHELTER AND ACROPOLIS

- Visit to Shelter for Unaccompanied Minors where you will facilitate a Workshop for the residents
- O Visit the Parthenon and the Acropolis Museum
- O Dinner and Celebration

DAY 6: ATHENS DEPARTURE

- Transport provided from city hotel to the airport
- Faculty are welcome to stay in Athens and travel at their own expense if they choose

FAQS

Who is invited on a Nursing Site Visit?

Any university/college faculty or administrator from across the country who is interested in and serious about offering a Kambia Nursing or program at their university in the future!

Where do we stay during our program?

Faculty will stay at one of GB lodging facilities in Athens. This would either be our GB lodging or a hotel located in the center of the city. Our team will share with you your assigned lodging. Double rooms with are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon request.

Is there a cost to participate in a Nursing Site Visit to Greece?

The Professional Development Fee of \$2200 includes airfare (up to \$1700) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transportation, and cultural activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit on behalf of the registered participant.

STEPS TO PARTICIPATE

- 1. Register: Please fill out the Nursing Site Visit Registration Form to confirm your attendance.
- **2. Submit Professional Development Fee:** Following registration, you will receive an email with a link to submit the <u>\$2200 per faculty member.</u>
- **3. Book Your Flight:** After receiving your Registration & Fee we connect you with our travel team to book your flight and provide pre-Site Visit materials and pre-program training
