



Business Academy's Summer Programs in **GREECE**



Global Business Academy's Summer Programs invite individual high school students and faculty-led chapters to join a cohort from across the country for an immersive, hands-on experience in international business. Students act as consultants alongside local business professionals to deliver business solutions to small-scale entrepreneurs in rural, under-resourced communities in Greece.

Days 1: Arrival and Orientation

Students are welcomed at the airport by program staff and transported to their accommodations. The evening begins with a welcome dinner, followed by an orientation covering program expectations, safety guidelines, logistics, and introductions to fellow participants and staff, setting the stage for an engaging week ahead.

Day 2: Greece in Context & Client Preparation

Students begin the program with an introduction to Greece's economic landscape and the local business environment, providing valuable context for the week ahead. In the afternoon, participants travel to meet their client organization for an introductory meeting, where they gain insight into the company's goals and challenges. The day concludes with team brainstorming sessions to develop initial ideas and deliverables, followed by reflection on key learnings.

Day 3: Client Engagement & Consulting Preparation

Students visit their client organization for a deeper understanding of the business and its operations. Working collaboratively, teams begin analyzing the client's needs and developing strategic recommendations. Evening activities include continued preparation for upcoming client meetings, along with team-building and networking opportunities.

Day 4: Business Consulting & Athens Exploration

The morning is dedicated to exploring modern Athens through a guided city walk, offering students a firsthand look at Greece's vibrant business, cultural, and historical landscape. In the afternoon, teams focus on refining their consulting recommendations before presenting progress updates to Global Business executives, receiving valuable professional feedback to strengthen their final presentations.

Day 5: Executive Presentations & Cultural Experience

Students deliver their final consulting presentations, showcasing the strategic solutions they have developed throughout the week. Following the presentations, participants enjoy free time to explore Athens at their own pace before gathering for an evening of Greek storytelling, local traditions, and cultural experiences.

Day 6: Presentation Celebration & Beach Day

The morning begins with a final client meeting and celebration of the consulting engagement, recognizing the accomplishments of both students and client partners. In the afternoon, participants unwind with a relaxing beach excursion, enjoying Greece's renowned coastline before an evening of leisure and reflection.

Day 7: Cultural Enrichment & Program Celebration

Students spend the day immersed in enriching cultural activities, gaining a deeper appreciation for Greece's history, traditions, and way of life. The program concludes with a celebratory dinner where participants reflect on their experiences, professional growth, and the relationships built throughout the week.

Day 8: Greece Departure and Return Home

Students are transported to the airport for their return journey home, leaving Greece with valuable international consulting experience, enhanced cross-cultural understanding, and lasting memories of their time abroad.

Program Funding Amount:

\$3,900 (inclusive of airfare up to \$2000, all in-country expenses, and clinic support)

Registration & Funding Dates:

- **Final Balance** funded by **May 20th**

FOOD & ACCOMMODATIONS

Private, secure home-base lodging facilities (hotels, eco-resorts, and guest houses) with controlled food preparation and accommodations for dietary preferences and allergies. At the home base, students enjoy shared meals and common areas, and are accommodated in private, same-sex rooms with 3–6 students per room and private bathrooms. Faculty are housed in private rooms.

STAFFING & TRANSPORTATION

Fully supervised programs supported by an experienced team of expertly trained coordinators, cooks, security personnel, drivers, paramedics, doctors, and translators who remain with the group 24/7. Private transportation is provided by professionally trained and insured drivers.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Established and trusted organization in Greece and the communities we serve, registered with the U.S. Embassy. Programs operate under clearly defined safety and behavioral protocols, with travel medical and full insurance coverage provided for all participants.

TERMS & EXPECTATIONS

The program fee includes airfare and all in-country expenses, including meals, lodging, transportation, scheduled activities, staffing, travel medical insurance, and a clinic contribution toward staffing, medications, and supplies.
