#### SAMPLE PROGRAM ITTNERARY

### DAY 1: GUATEMALA CITY ARRIVAL & ANTIGUA ORIENTATION

- Faculty travel to Guatemala City where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported to the Antigua Guatemala hotel
- Welcome 'Guatemalan Tipico' dinner and orientation with Country Director and In-Country Team

### DAY 2: ANTIGUA GUATEMALA EXPLORATION & PROGRAM PREPARATION

- Tour through Antigua City- World Heritage Site, cultural visit to the Jade Museum and Cerro de la Cruz.
- Enjoy a delicious lunch!
- Dinner and Evening preparation for community visits.

### DAY 3: COMMUNITY SITE VISIT AND SERVICE PROJECT, EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS

- Service Projects and Educational Workshops with the rural volunteer community and students at the host school
- Dinner at home-base and enjoy a tortilla cooking lesson and loteria game!







# DAY 4: LAKE ATITLAN WORLD HERITAGE SITE & GUATEMALA CITY RETURN

- Transport to Lake Atitlan World Heritage Site and town of Panajachel Hotel
- Boat tour across the lake to village of San Juan La Laguna Indigenous Woman Coop demo and chocolate making workshops.
- Return to Guatemala City hotel

### DAY 5: GUATEMALA PROGRAM CLOSURE & DEPARTURE

- Program closure
- Transport provided from city home base to the airport for those departing
- Faculty are welcome to stay and travel at own expense if they choose

#### Who is invited on a Site Visit?

Any High School faculty, administrators, and/or adult club leaders from across the country who are interested in and serious about offering a Squads Abroad volunteer travel program at their school in the future!

#### Where do we stay during a Site Visit?

Faculty stay in our nice partner 'homebase' hotel facilities throughout the program. Double rooms with private bath are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon availability at our facilities.

### Is there a cost to participate in an international Site Visit?

The Professional Development Fee of \$800 includes airfare (up to \$1000) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transport, and advertised activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit organization on behalf of the registered participant.
