SAMPLE PROGRAM ITINERARY

DAY 1: COMAYAGUA AIRPORT ARRIVAL & ORIENTATION

- Faculty travel to Comayagua City where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported to the hotel.
- Welcome dinner and orientation with Country Director and In-Country Team.

DAY 2 & 3 - VISIT PARTNER COMMUNITIES, MEET LOCAL MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS + EXPLORE HONDURAS

- Breakfast & Professional Development Workshops and meet local medical professionals to learn about our work and how you can get involved.
- Enjoy a delicious lunch!
- Visit partner communities in rural communities of Honduras and get introduced to local culture and understand the health and social environment of the country.
- Dinner and Evening Presentations.









DAY 4: PROGRAM CLOSURE AND DEPARTURE DAY

- Final closing meeting and reflection
- Departure Day Transport will be provided from the hotel to the airport for those departing.
- Faculty are welcome to stay in Honduras and travel at own expense if they choose

Who is invited on a Site Visit?

Any High School faculty, administrators, and/or adult club leaders from across the country who are interested in and serious about offering a Squads Abroad volunteer travel program at their school in the future!

Where do we stay on an Site Visit?

Faculty stay in our nice partner 'home base' hotel facilities throughout the program. Double rooms with private bath are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon availability at our facilities.

Is there a cost to participate in an International Site Visit?

The Professional Development Fee of \$1350 includes airfare (up to \$1000) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transport, and advertised activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit on behalf of the registered participant.
