SAMPLE PROGRAM ITINERARY

DAY 1: PANAMA CITY ARRIVAL & WELCOME DINNER WITH SQUADS PRESIDENT & GLOBAL BRIGADES' IN-COUNTRY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

- Faculty travel to Panama City where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported to a nearby hotel to meet our staff and get settled in.
- Welcome dinner in a traditional Panamanian restaurant with fellow faculty, the Squads Abroad staff and In-Country Directors.

DAY 2&3: COMMUNITY SITE VISITS, SERVICE PROJECTS, EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS IN RURAL/INDIGENOUS SCHOOLS/COMMUNITIES & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

- Community site visits, service projects, educational workshops in rural/indigenous communities at host schools
- Cultural Panamanian activities (mola, painting, make your own artisan souvenir out of soapstone, cooking a traditional Panamanian dish, etc.



DAY 4: PANAMA CANAL VISIT, TOUR AROUND CASCO VIEJO & FINAL CELEBRATORY DINNER

- Enrichment activities for this day includes a visit to the Panama Canal and tour around Casco Viejo where you are going to be able to do some shopping if wanted
- Final celebratory dinner with Squads President & in-country staff

DAY 5: PROGRAM CLOSURE & DEPARTURE DAY

- Program closure
- Departure Day - Transport will be provided from the Panama City hotel to the airport for those departing
- Faculty are welcome to stay and travel at own expense if they choose

Who is invited on a Site Visit?

Any High School Faculty, administrators, and/or adult club leaders from across the country who are interested in and serious about offering a Squads Abroad volunteer travel program at their school in the future!

Where do we stay during a Site Visit?

Faculty stay in our nice partner ‘homebase’ hotel facilities throughout the program. Double rooms with private bath are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon availability at our facilities.

Is there a cost to participate in an international Site Visit?

The Professional Development Fee of \$800 includes airfare (up to \$1,000) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transport, and advertised activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit organization on behalf of the registered participant.

Contact us to request further supporting documentation to cover the Professional Development Fee through school and departmental budgets.
